Overview: This manual labor role involves various cleaning and maintenance tasks.

Key Responsibilities:

- Using tools such as shovels, picks, wheelbarrows, and high-pressure water hoses
- Working in adverse conditions and inclement weather
- Following oral instructions with limited supervision
- Assisting skilled craft personnel as directed
- Safety Compliance
 - Adhere to safety protocols and guidelines during all training activities.
 - Participate in safety training sessions and demonstrate a commitment to creating a safe working environment

Requirements:

- Possession of a valid Alabama driver's license.
- High school diploma or equivalent. Additional previous training is a plus.
- Basic understanding of occupational hazards and safety precautions.
- Ability to work varying shifts in an industrial setting and in inclement weather.
- Ability to follow written and oral instructions and work collaboratively in a team environment.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Willingness to learn and adapt to new technologies and methodologies.
- Physical ability to climb stairs and ladders, work above ground level, lift heavy objects, mount and dismount equipment, and perform tasks requiring bending, stooping, kneeling, working from prone and overhead positions, and lifting up to 50 pounds.
