Overview: As a Heavy Equipment Operator Trainee, you will receive hands-on training and experience in operating and maintaining various types of heavy industrial equipment.

Key Responsibilities:

- Learning to operate terminal wheel loaders (small and 988), material handlers, and skid steers
- Assisting in handling equipment such as rubber-tired or track, straight or articulated vehicles with hydraulically powered attachments
- Training to scoop, lift, move, and transport bulk materials to and from storage or processing areas
- Learning to feed conveyors, hoppers, or chutes and load trucks or railcars
- Assisting in tasks such as excavations, grading road surfaces, digging ditches, laying pipe, stockpiling, and repairing washouts
- Helping to load and haul excavated soil, rock, and trash
- Learning to perform routine maintenance on equipment, including lubricating, fueling, and cleaning
- Interest in techniques, practices, and procedures used in handling bulk materials
- Willingness to learn hand signals and flagging used in operating large, motorized equipment
- Basic understanding of record-keeping procedures for preventative maintenance schedules
- Assisting work teams when not operating equipment and performing additional duties related to this field as assigned

- Participate in safety training sessions and demonstrate a commitment to creating a safe working environment
- Basic understanding of occupational hazards and safety precautions in operating heavy equipment

- Ability to work varying shifts in an industrial setting and in inclement weather.
