The Alabama Port Authority is pleased to submit our application for Project ANCHOR: Port of Mobile Master Plan and Infrastructure Development located in Mobile County, Alabama for funding through the FY 2026 Port Infrastructure Development Program (PIDP) Grant opportunity.

This application is for the development of a Master Plan for the entire Port of Mobile Alabama that will establish a comprehensive, long-term framework to guide future port related infrastructure investments that improve freight mobility, operational efficiency, and a state of good repair at the Port of Mobile Alabama. The grant will result in the design and construction of critical container storage infrastructure within the Port. The current estimated cost is \$72,351,810. The Alabama Port Authority is requesting USDOT discretionary funding for the abovementioned project in the amount of \$54,263,858 (75%). Furthermore, the Alabama Port Authority is committed to providing a local match of \$18,087,952 (25%). The proposed funding profile is shown below:
